

Gian Gabriele Franchi is Associate Professor of Pharmaceutical Biology at the University of Siena, Department of Medical, Surgical and Neurosciences. He has a degree in Natural Sciences and a diploma in Herbal Medicine.

He was a member of the CITES Scientific Commission (Commission on International Trade of Endangered Species) at the Ministry of the Environment, and a member of the Directive Board of the Italian Society of Phytotherapy and of the Italian Society of Pharmacognosy.

He was president of the Didactic Committee for Degree Courses and director or deputy director of 1st and 2nd level Masters.

He has held numerous courses including Pharmaceutical Botany, Pharmacognosy, Ethnobotany, Pharmacognosy and Phytotherapy. He currently teaches in the degree courses in Pharmacy, Dietetics and Biomedical Laboratory Techniques.

His research activity has mainly concerned medicinal plants and plant reproduction. He is the author of over 200 scientific publications, including in international journals.
