

Paola Massarelli is an Aggregate Professor at the University of Siena, ssd CHIM/08, and belongs to the Department of Medical, Surgical and Neuroscience Sciences.

She graduated with honors in Pharmacy and obtained her Ph.D. in Pharmaceutical Sciences at the University of Siena.

Her research activity has concerned the synthesis of new molecules with potential pharmacological activity and in more recent years the study of natural products, both taking care of the extraction methodologies and the related *in vitro* and *in vivo* tests. She is author of numerous scientific publications, including in international journals, the list of which can be consulted on the University website.

She has also been a referee for international journals, such as Arabian Journal of Chemistry, Bioorganic & Medicinal Chemistry, Bioorganic & Medicinal Chemistry Letters, British Journal of Medicine and Medical Research, British Journal of Pharmaceutical Research, Biomedicine & Pharmacotherapy, Bioorganic Chemistry, Phytomedicine Plus.

From 1999 to 2021 she was a member of the Council of the Order of Pharmacists of the Province of Siena where she held the position of Secretary starting from 2002.

She was a member of the Wide South East Area Ethics Committee for the three-year period 2021-2023 (resolution of the Director General of the AOUS no. 324 of 06.03.2021).
