### ALESSANDRO GIOVANNINI

Born in Livorno on 25 October 1962, he completed his studies at the University of Pisa, graduating in Law with 110 out of 110 cum laude.

Full professor of tax law at the University of Siena.

He was national president of the Italian Association of Tax Law Professors (AIPDT)

Author of eight monographic works published for the types of Giuffrè, Cedam, NelDiritto and FrancoAngeli, director of the Treaty of Tax Sanction Law, published by Giuffrè, and author of about 200 minor works published in major national and international magazines.

Author of encyclopedic entries, including Contribution capacity (art.53 of the Constitution), published by Treccani, Tax Subject, edited by Treccani, Professionisti, edited by Utet for the Italian Digest, and National Consolidation published by Utet for the Italian Digest.

Founder and co-editor of the quarterly review of tax law. Cassation lawyer, accountant and statutory auditor.

#### UNIVERSITY STATUS AND CURRICULUM

From 1986 to 1991 he was enrolled as an expert on the subject at the chair of tax law of the Faculty of Law of the University of Pisa.

In 1987 he participated in the competition for the "Antonio Pesenti" study prize for the best degree thesis in legal and economic sciences from the University of Pisa, and was the winner.

In 1987 he also participated in the national competition at the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna in Pisa, obtaining the qualification for specialization.

From 1991 to 1998 he was a researcher in tax law at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Pisa.

In the academic year 1995-1996 he obtained the substitute teaching of tax law at the Faculty of Law of the same University and from the academic year 1997-1998 to the academic year 2002-2003 the assignment of teaching in the Faculty of Economics.

From 1998 to 2001 he was associate professor of tax law in the "Richard M. Goodwin" Faculty of Economics of the University of Siena. Since 2001 he has been full professor at the same Faculty, now Department of Business and Legal Studies, of the same University.

In the academic year 2011-2012 he was awarded the teaching of tax law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Pisa (master's degree course) and in the academic year 2012-2013 at the Faculty of Economics of the same University (three-year course and specialist course) and at the Naval Academy of Livorno (master's degree). For the academic year 2013-2014 he kept teaching at the Naval Academy of Livorno.

#### PATH AND SCIENTIFIC, TEACHING AND PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCES

From 1991 to 1996 he taught at the L.U.I.S.S. "Guido Carli" in Rome and the "Ezio Vanoni" School of Economics and Finance in Rome.

In 1991 he participated in the strategic project C.N.R. on "The ways of forming laws", in charge of Prof. G. Visintini and Prof. V. Uckmar,

In 1995 he participated in the C.N.E.L. "Tax ordered", directed by Prof. V. Uckmar.

He was a member of the Ministerial Commission for the reform of tax sanctions, appointed by the Minister of Finance with a decree of 10 January 1997. He was a member of the Ministerial Commission for the drafting of the Consolidated

Income Tax Act, appointed by the Minister of Finance with a decree February 17, 2000.

From the academic year 2000 to the academic year 2006 he was a member of the teaching staff of the research doctorate in "Tax procedural law" with administrative headquarters at the University of Pisa.

From the academic year 2002 to the academic year 2006 he was director of the University Master in Tax Law, established by the Department of Economic Law of the University of Siena, in agreement with the Faculty of Law of the University of Pisa and the Revenue Agency, Regional Directorate of Revenue for the Tuscany.

In 2006 he completed a study stay at the "Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne" University, Research and Training Unit (URF) 3, Law, conducting research on "abuse of law" and "property taxation".

In 2008 he was appointed member of the Study Commission for the revision of the legislation on the "Third sector", established by the "National Agency of non-profit organizations of social utility", in collaboration with the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna of Pisa.

In 2010 he was Leader Project in the U.E. "Twinning", on behalf of the Ministry of the Interior of the Romanian Republic, for the revision and updating of the legislation on the processing of personal data and confidentiality in tax matters. He was also a speaker at the Government of the Romanian Republic.

In 2011 he was elected a member of the Governing Council of the Italian Association of Tax Law Professors (AIPDT), of which he was national secretary and delegate for legislative reforms and cultural initiatives.

In 2013 he was elected national president of the Italian Association of Tax Law Professors.

Since 2012 he has been a lecturer at the II level Master in Tax Law established by the Catholic University of the "Sacred Heart" of Milan. Since the same year he has been a lecturer at the Course for tax magistrates established by the National Council for the Presidency of Tax Justice.

He is a member of the scientific committees of the "Bruno Visentini Foundation", based in Rome, of the "National Foundation for Chartered Accountants and Accounting Experts", based in Rome, and is Scientific Director of the Italian Association of Tax Justice Professionals, based in Rome.

Expert member of the National Bar Council (CNF) for the "Tax Law" commission. Founder and co-editor of the quarterly review of tax law. He is a member of the management committee of the review of tax law and of the magazine Innovation and law; it was the case of the magazine "Finanza locale", the magazine "Giustizia tributaria" and the magazine "Tributimpresa".

He is a member of the Scientific Committee of the Auditors of Italian Law, Tax Review, Tax Law Review, International Tax Law Review, Tax Law and Practice, Financial Law and Finance Law Review, Business Law Review.

In addition to being the author of eight monographic works published for the types of Giuffrè, Cedam, NelDiritto and FrancoAngeli; director of the treaty on tax sanctions, published by Giuffrè; author of about 200 minor works published in the major national and international magazines and author of numerous encyclopedic entries, including Contribution capacity (art.53 of the Constitution) published by Treccani, Tax subject published by Treccani, Professionisti, published by Utet for the Italian Digest, and National Consolidation published by Utet for the Italian Digest, has been a speaker at over 300 national and international conferences. He writes for national and local newspapers.
