

FABIO GABBRIELLI – CURRICULUM

Graduate in Letters at the University of Siena, in 1997 he took a Doctor's Degree in History of Architecture and Urban Planning at the University Institute of Architecture of Venice. In 1998 he won a post-doctorate scholarship at the University of Siena and in 2005 he took service as Researcher in History of Architecture. He was "Professore Aggregato" from 2005-06 and he has been "Professore Associato" in History of Architecture since 2015-16. He was Director of the "Inter-Department Center for the study of Santa Maria della Scala Hospital" from 2006 to 2012, and he was Director of the "School of Specialization in Historical and Artistic Heritage" at the University of Siena from 2016 to 2019.

In 2018 he obtained the national scientific qualification as Full Professor in History of Architecture.

The research activity has been mainly orientated toward four aspects: the history of Medieval architecture in Tuscany, constructive and decorative techniques, neo-medieval architecture, methods of analysis and dating of historical building. He took part, with written presentations, in national and international meetings (Barcelona, Berlin, Braga, Paris, Léon, Marrakesh, Siviglia, etc). He is co-director of "Ricerche e fonti", the book series of the "Inter-Department Center for the Study of Santa Maria della Scala Hospital" (then "Center for the Study of Historical Hospitals", University of Siena).
