

After graduating from the Liceo Classico E. S. Piccolomini in Siena, in the academic year 1983/84 he graduated with a mark of 110 cum laude from the Faculty of Law of the University of Siena, discussing a thesis in Administrative Law entitled "The privatisation of public bodies". The dissertation was awarded the prize of the 'Umberto Borsi' Institute of Administrative Studies in Bologna as the best dissertation in administrative law.

Immediately after graduation, he is a lecturer at the Administrative Law Department of the Faculty of Law of the University of Siena with Prof. Enzo Balocchi and Prof. Maria Cristina Mascambruno, under whose responsibility he conducts seminars, tutorials, supplementary teaching activities and initiates research activities. He also collaborates on courses in Local Authority Law and General Organisation Theory.

Since 1 November 1990, he has been a Researcher in Administrative Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Siena and, in 1993, he was admitted as a confirmed university researcher.

From 1990 to 1995, he was an adjunct lecturer in the Public Law course at the Scuola diretta a fini speciali per Assistenti Sociali in Siena.

In the academic years 1990/91, 1991/92, 1992/93, he lectured at the Scuola diretta a fini speciali per Consulenti del Lavoro of the University of Siena on the course of Labour Administrative Law.

In the academic years 1990/91, 1991/92, 1992/93, she carried out supplementary teaching activities at the Scuola diretta a fini speciali per Operatori Turistici dell'Università di Siena, based in Grosseto, on the Institutions of Public Law course.

In 1991, he taught at the refresher course for municipal and provincial secretaries organised by the Prefecture of Siena.

In the period 1993-2002, he was entrusted with teaching Administrative Law at the School of Specialisation in Hygiene and Preventive Medicine of the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Siena.

Again in the period 1993-2002, he was entrusted with teaching Hospital Legislation at the School of Specialisation in Hygiene and Preventive Medicine of the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Siena.

In 1995, he was a lecturer at the Course for the professional development of local authority officials promoted by the Region of Tuscany. Since the 1994/95 academic year he has been entrusted with teaching local authority law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Siena, a subject for which he is still full professor in the Degree Course in Law at the Department of Law of the University of Siena.

From 1995 to 1998, he was a lecturer in the Specialisation Course for Operators of Eco-Environmental Management for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises organised by the 'Leonardo da Vinci' Institute in Empoli on behalf of the Ministry of Public Administration.

From 1995 to 2000 he taught Local Authority Law at the Training Course in Planning and Evaluation of Social Services at the Scuola diretta a fini speciali per Assistenti Sociali of the University of Siena.

From 1999 to 2001 he was a lecturer in the Advanced Course for Experts in Environmental Legislation, organised by the University of Siena in collaboration with Toscana Ambiente.

From 2001 until 2007, he taught Municipal and Provincial Law in the three-year degree courses in Legal Sciences, Business Law, International Law and Organisation, and in the Master's degree course in Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Siena.

During the same period, he taught Local Authority Law in the three-year degree courses in Legal Sciences, Business Law, International Law and Organisation, and in the Master's degree course in Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Siena.

From 2004 until 2008 he taught Administrative Law (Advanced Course) in the Degree Course in Legal Sciences and Administrative Systems at the Faculty of Law, University of Siena (Grosseto campus).

From 2006 to 2010 he taught Administration Science in the University Master's Degree Course in "Planning and Evaluation of Social Services, Social and Health Services and Social Enterprise" organised by the Faculty of Political Science of the University of Siena.

From 2008 to 2011, he taught Administrative Law in the Master's Degree Course in Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Siena (Grosseto campus).

In 2011-2012, he lectured in the University Master's Course in 'Public Administrations, Enterprises, Workers: The Management of Public Contracts' at the University of Siena.

From 2011 to 2014 he taught Regional Law and Local Authorities Law in the three-year degree course in Economics and Territorial Development at the Faculty of Economics 'R. M. Goodwin' of the University of Siena (Grosseto campus).

Since 2000 he has been a lecturer delegated for orientation and tutoring activities by the Department of Law. In this capacity he is a member of the University Commission for Orientation and Tutoring.

From 2012-2014, he is a member of the Teaching Committee of the Degree Course in Labour Consultants and Trade Union Relations at the Department of Law, University of Siena.

Since 2015, he has been a member of the Teaching Committee of the Master of Laws degree course at the Department of Law, University of Siena.

Since the 2021-2022 academic year, he has been teaching Local Authorities Law and Urban Safety Policies as part of the degree course in Legal Services at the Department of Law, University of Siena.

Over the years, he has participated in university research on topics such as administrative procedure, waste management, local administration in Europe (in particular, on Spanish local administration).

He is the author of publications on public service broadcasting, sports promotion bodies, controls on banking activity, administrative procedure, public safety and urban security. In more recent publications, he has dealt with legal issues concerning university guidance and tutoring activities.
