

Paolo Piccari is associate professor of Theoretical Philosophy.

He obtained the national scientific qualification for the functions of full professor (M-FIL/01) in March 2017.

He is the scientific director of *Ethos Observatory* - Public ethics, bioethics and social responsibility at the University of Siena and member of the teaching committee of the master's degree course in History and Philosophy.

He is co-director of the series «Oltre/Orizzonti di teoresi filosofica» (Mimesis) and of the scientific journal "Arkete".

He has been a visiting scholar at the University of Oxford and the Faculty of Theology of Lugano.

He is member of SIFIT (Italian Society of Theoretical Philosophy) and SIPS (Society for the Progress of Sciences), member of the Scientific Committee of *Ethos Observatory* at the Luiss Business School and member of the Teaching Board of the PhD course in "Learning and innovation in social and work contexts".

He is also a member of the Board of Directors of the National Consumers Union and of the General Council of the Forum ANIA-Consumatori, of which he was vice-president, and of the Technical Commission "Social Responsibility of Organizations" – UNI.

He was a member of the National Users Council at the Communications Regulatory Authority (AGCOM) and the National Council of Consumers and Users at the Ministry of Development Economic (MISE).

Member of the Order of Journalists since 1992, he collaborated with the newspaper "la Repubblica" and the weekly "Christian Family". He has also participated as an expert in several television programs, including *Uno Mattina* (RAI UNO).
