

Riccardo Mussari is professor of Public Financial Management. He received his Ph.D. in Business Administration from the University of Pisa (Italy) defending a thesis focused on public management theory. During his academic carrier he has been visiting scholar at several European, US, Australian and Japanese Universities. He has published on public sector accounting and management issues, with refereed articles in international journals. He is also author and co-editor of several public sector management and accounting books. He is an active researcher being part of major national and international research projects (including Erasmus Plus, COST, and Horizon 2020). Prof. Mussari is member of the Scientific Boards of national and international academic journals, and editor in chief of "*Azienda Pubblica*", the leading Italian academic journal of Public Accounting and Public Management. His research and teaching interests include public sector management, accounting and budgeting, public value, policy and program evaluation, performance measurement and management in public sector organisations and public governance. More recently, he started studying two "new" topics: risk analysis and anti-corruption strategies in public sector organisations and the costs of governmental regulation. Prof. Mussari is fully involved also in Italian (he his Vice President of the Italian Society of Accounting and Business Administration Professors) and International Academic Associations (he was President of the International Public Management Network). He held also important academic/managerial responsibilities. At University of Siena he was: director of the PhD program in Business Administration, Head of the Department of Business and Social Studies, President of the Council of the Heads of the Departments. Prof. Mussari was President and C.E.O. of a Public Corporation (the fiscal agency of the Municipality of Rome) and member of the Boards of two non-profit organisations. Even though he is an academic, Prof. Mussari personally engaged also in giving Italian Central Government and public organisations support and advice. At present, his main commitments are: member of the Public Sector Accounting Standard Commission at the Ministry of Economy and Finance; President of the Evaluation Body of CREA (Council for the Research in Agriculture) the largest Italian research centre in agriculture, controlled by Italian Central Government; Coordinator of a research group, composed of Business Administration scholars, focused on "Measuring the risk of corruption at a territorial level and promoting transparency", a research program promoted by the Anti-Corruption Italian Authority; Member of the Scientific Committee and of the National Delivery Unit for the calculation of the administrative burdens, Department of Public Administration, Italian Central Government. In addition, Prof. Mussari is qualified as External expert to support

the implementation of structural reforms in the member States" - EU Structural Reform Support Services list - Thematic fields: Budget preparation and execution; Accounting and financial reporting; Spending reviews; Fiscal strategy and tax policy.
